

ST. FRANCIS DE SALES VOCATIONS CULTURE PROGRAM

St. Francis de Sales, in Newark Ohio, is a K-8 school in the Catholic Diocese of Columbus. Their mission is to create a loving and caring Catholic community that uses education to support all children in becoming the best they can be in mind, body, and spirit. Sally Mummey, the school principal, and Fr. David Sizemore, Pastor, are committed to a well-rounded education for their students including the area of vocations.

Maggie Wright, St. Francis' Director of Finance & Development, applied for and was awarded a grant from The Catholic Foundation to create and execute a Vocations Culture Program. This program, which fits within St. Francis de Sales' mission to 'Make Disciples and Disciple Makers', uses promotional materials and books to cultivate awareness of Vocations in families and school-age youth. To create a culture of Vocations awareness among younger children and families, the books are read to children in class by a Priest, Deacon, Seminarian, or other Religious. Information is also sent home with the children to aid in family discussion. To foster the Vocations Culture among young men in the parish, St. Francis de Sales hosts a vocations study led by the Parish Priest and Youth Minister, using the free materials from the Melchizedek Project. The Melchizedek Project educates and inspires Catholic students to consider a vocation to the priesthood. Saint Francis also offers two retreats for Vocations discernment in the Spring and Summer. The first was for young men under 18 held at Damascus Camp. The retreat included Mass, Confession, Liturgy of the Hours, talks, breakout sessions, leisure and team building activities, and more. The second was a Canoeing/Camping retreat for men 18 years of age and older. Activities on the Canoeing Retreat included daily Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, Study, Quiet Reflection, and time for bonding while canoeing down the Muskingum River.

Dan Kurth, VP of Grants at The Catholic Foundation said, "St. Francis de Sales has been a long-standing pillar of faith in the Licking County community. The Catholic Foundation is proud to help support a parish which has produced so many priests in our Diocese. St. Francis de Sales' Vocation Culture project is aiming to increase awareness among families about vocations and generate a discussion around the dinner table. We are very excited that a parish has decided to put such an enormous emphasis on vocations and are hopeful that these efforts will produce great results."

The key to this program is to expose families to religious life, as St. Francis has many students who have never met a sister and don't understand what it means or how to go about discerning religious life. Recognizing the disconnect between families hearing about Vocations in a book and seeing it living in front of you, St. Francis' has set its goals based on individual and family involvement. The primary goal is to have a minimum of 45 young men participate in the study discerning the priesthood. The secondary goal is to get 50% of all school families to make a commitment to pray for Vocations in their families and/or the parish. Maggie said, "We hope to create a strong culture of vocations within St. Francis de Sales for the greater good of the Church. We want

to help in any way we can to increase vocations to the Catholic priesthood by fostering awareness and education in our youth."

Statistics demonstrate the relevance and importance of St. Francis' Vocations program. In the Diocese of Columbus, we have 278,528 active Catholics and only 97 diocesan priests, 36 religious priests, and 23 external priests to serve them. That is only one priest per 1,785 Catholics. Additionally, there are only 35 seminarians currently in formation and statistically only ¾ of those will make it to ordination. This program is therefore essential to increase vocations and to actively feed the faith and serve the good people of the Diocese of Columbus.

This program is only one example of the strong partnership between St. Francis and the Foundation. Maggie said "The Catholic Foundation has been instrumental in the development of St. Francis de Sales. At one point, we were seeing a decline in membership, in the offertory, and we had no programming or ministries around adult faith formation. The Catholic Foundation worked with us to put together a plan for growth and they have been instrumental to that growth." And it's working! St. Francis de Sales has gone from a declining offertory of \$700,000 to well over a million, a 900 mass count to that of almost 1,200, and the school has grown from 242 to 270 students. Families and parishioners are returning home as St. Francis continues to work every day to help grow the already-strong Catholic community in Licking County.

ST. VINCENT FAMILY CENTER

On February 2, 1875, the original St. Vincent Orphanage began caring for 8 young children, displaced from their families with no place to call home. More than 140 years later, the mission, now named the St. Vincent Family Center has evolved into a comprehensive behavioral health agency it is today, meeting the changing needs of over 5,000 children and families a year. St. Vincent Family Center offers a unique, trauma-informed approach to behavioral health treatment, supporting entire families as they heal from life's challenges.

The Catholic Foundation is proud to partner with the team of the St. Vincent Family Center to support the ongoing needs of underserved children and families in our central Ohio community. The roots of St. Vincent Family Center run deep on the near east side of Columbus, and just like their little ones, sometimes they need a little extra care. The Catholic Foundation was instrumental in funding two mission-critical projects at St. Vincent Family Center in 2018 – a vital boiler repair and a transformation initiative to update information technology (IT) systems. The building's boiler replacement not only provided necessary upgrades to the agency's campus, it also ensured hundreds of children remained safe and warm inside St. Vincent Family Center during the cold winter months. "A working boiler system is critical to our everyday service delivery," shares St. Vincent Family Center President and CEO Susan Lewis Kaylor. "We provide essential healthcare programs to more than 200 at-risk youth in our building every day – residents, students and family clients. We are so grateful for the immediate response of The Catholic Foundation during our time of need, providing critical support toward this unexpected financial burden."

The Catholic Foundation also provided \$48,000 in seed money to fund Phase 1 of St. Vincent Family Center's IT transformation efforts, an initiative dedicated to increasing access to care for needy families and improving program efficiencies. "Early support from The Catholic Foundation financed the first steps we needed to create a foundation for safe and secure IT systems," says Kaylor. "The Catholic Foundation believed in our strategy from the beginning, and we could not have achieved initial success without the faith and investment they demonstrated." St. Vincent Family Center continues to advance their IT operations and efficiencies thanks to this critical early investment from The Catholic Foundation.

The mission of St. Vincent Family Center is simply put – "We Make Good Kids Better." Each of these projects is rooted in that very mission, ensuring more children in desperate need of hope and support are cared for safely at St. Vincent Family Center. And the results are clear. Parents and families shared these sentiments about their experience at St. Vincent Family Center:

"The facility lives up to its name – they're all about family and children, helping you and your children to become better than you were before."

"The team at St. Vincent Family Center is very professional and courteous, they treat me and my son with dignity and respect."

ST. CECILIA'S CULTURAL DIVERSITY SPECIALIST

Saint Cecilia Parish is located on the west side of Columbus, Ohio and has over 1,100 families in a thirty-one square mile territory. The parish's elementary school accommodates girls and boys of all races and faiths as long as the families honestly support the educational program and expression of the Catholic faith. Students at St. Cecilia learn in a warm and risk-free environment where they are empowered to be independent critical thinkers who strive to make positive differences in their community. Students develop as caring and responsible citizens by learning and practicing the Catholic faith through weekly mass, daily religion class, receiving the sacraments, and taking part in prayer services. By working closely with the parish, St. Cecilia School promotes life-long learning of the Catholic faith and an ongoing relationship with God.

The principal of St. Cecilia, Lori Smith, was thrilled to learn that they were just ending their first year of a three-year grant from The Catholic Foundation for the school's Cultural Diversity Specialist. The person who originally had the job accepted another job elsewhere and Lori had the opportunity to apply her vision to this position. She knew that she wanted someone that had a strong presence in the Latino community, and she knew this person would need to work with a diverse group of families from Mexico, Ecuador, Peru, El Salvador, Dominican Republic, Honduras, Nicaragua, and Venezuela. Laura Kreber heard about the position and spoke with Lori and immediately knew it was the perfect fit. Facing a huge undertaking, Laura immediately instilled trust and affection with her warm and welcoming personality in her new role as a community liaison. Watching Laura grow and flourish in this position, Lori knew she made the right decision. Lori said that the school is already at 49 Latino families and, because the word is spreading of Laura's work, they are receiving daily phone calls for more information.

Laura has been the Cultural Diversity Specialist at St. Cecilia for almost two years now. Laura says, "It has been wonderful to help the families and students at St. Cecilia and be the bridge between the school, the parish, and the families. When Latino families show up and there are language barriers, I help explain what services they need. These can also be sacramental needs and when that happens, I can explain to Father the cultural differences so he can be sensitive and aware of them." Laura also translates all communications that go home with the students and addresses any questions, comments, and concerns that students may have that can't be expressed in English. A growing issue, due to ever-increasing and changing immigration regulations, is the amount of paperwork that Latino families are required to fill out and file. Laura walks families through the process and helps them understand how to fill out the required paperwork. "It can be heartbreaking sometimes to see because they want to do things right and legally but are oftentimes confused and don't understand what is required of them," said Laura.

In the summer of 2019, a handful of St. Cecilia employees, including Laura, Lori, and Father Leo Connolly, participated in the Latino Enrollment Institute (LEI) classes offered through Notre Dame. National data suggests that Latinos are both the fastest-growing segment of

the U.S. Catholic Church and the most underserved by Catholic schools. In response to these findings, The University of Notre Dame's Catholic School Advantage program founded LEI in 2012. This initiative identifies and assists Catholic schools with substantial unmet capacity (open seats), favorable demographic potential—namely, a growing number of Latino families in the surrounding area—and motivated principals by offering a framework to transform schools in order to attract and serve Latino families. Father Connolly, especially, fell in love with this program and the resources they received on how to make St. Cecilia Parish and School a warm and welcoming environment for everyone.

When asked how it was working with The Catholic Foundation and going through the grant process, Lori said "The grant process has been very easy. I

ST. THOMAS ABUINAS PAKISH

The historic St. Thomas Aquinas Church in Zanesville, Ohio was built in 1842 and added to the National Historic Registry in 1980. The parish was under the pastoral care of the Dominican Fathers until August 2017 and is now administered by the clergy of the Diocese of Columbus. The new pastor of Saint Thomas Aquinas, Father Jan Sullivan, was born in Columbus and grew up on the far Eastside near Reynoldsburg, in Saint Pius X Parish. He was ordained a Priest by Bishop Griffin in June 1991 and has 19 years of experience as a Parish Priest: at Saint Colman of Cloyne in Washington Court House, Saint Francis de Sales in Newark, and now at Saint Thomas Aquinas.

When Father Sullivan was appointed pastor of Saint Thomas, he worked with the church's finance committee (Tom Barone, Michael Morris, Ruth Ann Lynn, and Brent Mirgon) to look at the resources of the parish and see how to be a good steward of the parish's resources entrusted in his care. Father Sullivan said, "I have personally witnessed the benefit of being associated with The Catholic Foundation during my time at other parishes through the grants we received to fund parish ministries and to help finance capital repairs and improvements. Even now, St. Thomas has a grant from The Catholic Foundation to help fund an integrated parish CCD and Youth ministry program. I know of their work and it was a logical conclusion to see how the Foundation could assist us in securing our financial resources for future benefits and ministries."


Saint Thomas' experience with investing parish funds began about thirty years ago when a devout and loyal parishioner left a very large bequest to the parish. She had a humble and quiet life working as a laundress for most of her adult life and it wasn't until she died that Saint Thomas was informed she left an \$800,000 estate gift to the parish. Father Sullivan said he felt he owed it to loyal and faithful donors, like these, to steward and manage the money that they had worked hard to save their entire lives in accordance with their wishes.

To insure the parish was in compliance with policies of the Diocese of Columbus regarding parish investments Father Sullivan spoke with Loren Brown, President and CEO at The Catholic Foundation, to find a win-win situation where Saint Thomas could take advantage of the Foundation's Professional Advisor Choice Program and implement the long standing diocesan financial policy. St. Thomas would move their long-term investments to The Catholic Foundation while maintaining a relationship with a local investment manager. Not only was Father Sullivan, and the parish finance committee happy with the solution, but the local investment firm was also appreciative and collaborated in making this transition, because it allowed the firm to offer their client (Saint Thomas) a continued level of commitment and service. Loren Brown said, "I am happy that we were able to help Father Sullivan and Saint Thomas Aquinas parish. This is really important to them."

An Endowment Fund provides a source of annual income to a Catholic organization of your choice, like St. Thomas Aquinas. This fund is designed to function in perpetuity, making it possible for you to ensure long-term financial support. Once established, anyone can make additional contributions to the fund in any dollar amount.

Now that Saint Thomas' investment funds are being overseen by The Catholic Foundation, Father Sullivan is working to educate the parish on planned giving options and its crucial impact on St. Thomas' future sustainability. Fr. Sullivan will begin a series of meetings and gatherings over the next year informing parishioners on how they too can continue supporting St. Thomas through its Endowment Fund at the Foundation to ensure its future even after they have gone to their eternal reward. Father Sullivan said, "I have always found The Catholic Foundation and Loren to be very helpful. In all my meetings with him over the past seven years he has been very supportive of me and my pastoral responsibilities and helped me to look for ways the Foundation can help in any particular situation."

MAKTHAS

The St. Martha Giving Circle, better known as The Marthas, was established in 2014 as an initiative dedicated to bringing Catholic women together to raise awareness and funds for organizations in the Diocese of Columbus. A giving circle by design, The Marthas leverage a pooled fund to have a greater philanthropic impact on selected organizations.

Throughout the year, The Marthas gather to learn about organizations and their needs and decide together which projects to financially support. There are also opportunities to share ideas, serve with one another, grow deeper in the Catholic faith, socialize, and learn about the ongoing needs throughout the Diocese. Every Spring, The Marthas nominate, vote, and award money from their donor advised fund to organizations in the Diocese of Columbus. Each organization is vetted by The Catholic Foundation's VP of Grants and Community Impact to ensure that they are in alignment with Catholic values and beliefs.

This past year, The Marthas awarded \$45,000 to ten amazing organizations, including Mommies Matter. Mommies Matter empowers single mothers to choose life for their babies by breaking down their barriers. As an extension of pregnancy care services, Mommies Matter walks with single mothers through their pregnancies and until their babies are 18 months old by offering a variety of services and support. Every woman is a gift to her child and, as such, Mommies Matter offers each mother a GIFT; Group support, Individualized assistance, Financial assistance, and Therapy.

Executive Director, Monica Flynn, was one of The Marthas' panelist speakers in March 2019. Monica said she has seen a

lot of positive feedback in both donations and in volunteers after her presentation. "There has been a residual effect of people reaching out wanting to get involved and support these brave and wonderful women in their journey." It's obvious that Monica and Mommies Matter has also had an impact on The Marthas, as they were awarded the second highest grant of \$7,000. That \$7,000 is instrumental in administering the services that Mommies Matter provides to hundreds of women in central Ohio. There have been over 6,000 volunteer hours since last September and with that comes increased personnel time and resources. The Marthas' grant has provided many services including helping a young woman buy a car, drivers education classes, and the hiring of two new part-time personnel. "Beyond the emotional and physical needs of a mother there are very real-life, tangible things that need to be addressed in order for them to succeed...such as reliable transportation. And support, like this grant helps make that possible," said Monica.



The volunteers and staff members of Mommies Matter are committed to building deep, and oftentimes, ongoing, relationships with these brave women. This is the heart behind Mommies Matter's belief that"it's the difference between giving birth and giving life". The hope of Mommies Matter is that these very relationships awaken the desire for other life-giving relationships in the individual's life." Monica said, "We look forward to the next part of their journey, helping them see that whatever past decisions or traumas they experienced do not define them but rather made them who they are today. We go through life together. Healing and moving towards Christ."

Monica said, "The Marthas and The Catholic Foundation continually support organizations like ours and it's genuine. They really do want to make our community a better place and put our Catholic faith into action."

The Catholic Foundation's Professional Advisors Group (PAG) is comprised of trusted professionals including estate planning lawyers, financial planners, insurance professionals, accountants, funeral directors, and trust officers. Additionally, for those individuals who feel called to partner with the Foundation to make a gift to charity aligned with Catholic values and beliefs, but wish to retain their existing financial advisor, The Catholic Foundation offers the Professional Advisor Choice program. In this program the financial advisor continues to manage contributed funds but are required to invest in predetermined mutual funds that comply with The Catholic Foundation's Investment Policy. This program begins with contributions at \$50,000 or above, including in-kind conversions.

Chris Doyle, First Vice President and Wealth Management Advisor for Merrill Lynch contacted The Catholic Foundation shortly before Christmas 2018 to inquire about the Foundation's Donor Advised Funds (DAF) service and whether the Foundation offered an advisors choice program. As an advisor himself, having this option available was important to Chris personally. But it was also important to Chris professionally, because his clients trust him to take care of all their financial needs, understand their goals, and recommend appropriate solutions, including their charitable giving. Chris said, "People are in different stages of their lives at any given time and that usually requires a more sophisticated solution to solve their financial needs and the Advisor Choice Program accomplishes that goal". After a few meetings with David Clark, Development Officer, and Loren Brown, President & CEO, Chris knew that he wanted his family's Donor Advised Fund to be at The Catholic Foundation.



Chris said, "My family and I have been fortunate enough to be in a position where we can make donations to worthy causes and I would like to incorporate my children in this concept. I started with The Catholic Foundation DAF because I want to instill my Catholic values and philanthropy system, into my kids." About nine years ago Chris started a tradition with his children where they would sit down at the table at Thanksgiving and everyone would say what they were thankful for. Additionally, he and his wife gave each of them \$50. They were told to pick a charity, do research on that group, address the envelope, and mail the check. The tradition was so well loved they have done it every year since and the amount has been bumped up to \$100. Not only did this tradition get the children excited, but it started instilling in them the values and importance of philanthropy and what it means to give back. It can be very easy to get lost in dayto-day survival mode, and it was important to Chris and his family that they take a step back, look at the bigger picture, and remember that we are all working our way towards a

greater purpose and destination. The Catholic Foundation enabled the Doyle family to have multiple generations run the fund and truly make it a fund rooted in faith and family.

Chris said, "Working with David has been terrific. The Catholic Foundation has excellent people who will work together with an advisor. ST. JOHN FISHER STEWARDS

Bishop Frederick Campbell identified St. John Fisher as the patron saint of The Catholic Foundation because of his stewardship of endowments, particularly St. John's College, England. The St. John Fisher Stewards are volunteers of the parish, that promote the growth of the parish endowments through collaboration with The Catholic Foundation's awareness and service initiatives. Some parishes such as Church of the Resurrection, New Albany have created their own ministry to promote their endowments and planned giving. The Foundation works with these ministries under the umbrella of the St. John Fisher Stewards program, which offers resources to help them promote, plan, and educate.

Resurrection's Legacy Society was established in 2018. It was formed to inspire giving and assist parishioners in providing for the long-term needs of the parish and the future sustainability of their ministries. This group primarily focuses on achieving these goals through legacy gifts to parish endowment funds managed in partnership by The Catholic Foundation. Partnering with the Foundation, the Legacy Society:

- PROMOTES legacy giving by recognizing parishioners and others who make a commitment to the future of Resurrection by making a Legacy Gift.
- **EDUCATES** the parish by visiting with parishioners and others who want to learn more about a long-term planned gift for
- **HELP WITH PLANNING**, to ensure that all donors' charitable giving needs are met.

In 1994, Bishop James A. Griffin offered to establish an endowment fund for 13 parishes with an initial deposit to each parish. Church of the Resurrection was one of the 13 parishes and \$1,000 was given to establish the "Church of the Resurrection Parish Endowment Fund". This fund provides for the general needs of the parish. The Church of the Resurrection endowment funds have grown to include:

- Church of the Resurrection Music Ministry Endowment Fund
- Church of the Resurrection Social Concerns Ministry Endowment Fund
- Steele Family Endowment Fund
- Church of the Resurrection Capital Infrastructure Needs
- Church of the Resurrection Catholic Education Student Aid

One Legacy Society member, Jim Vonau, said that working with The Catholic Foundation has been great because they don't have to reinvent the wheel. He said, "The Foundation has been great with helping steer us in different directions on what might work based on what has been done in the past with other parishes or groups."





One of the more successful initiatives of the Legacy Society began when the parish debt was paid and The Legacy Society approached donors who had generously given monthly to the campaign, asking them to consider continuing their contributions to one of their endowment funds. This has been incredibly successful and has helped grow Resurrection's funds by 63% in the past 18 months. Suzanne Larson, Business Manager for Resurrection said, "I've been at the parish for ten years and planning for the future is really important. We have done a really good job planning for our physical infrastructure and putting money away for projects. And the way I see it, Planned Giving is just another way of ensuring the future of our Church and our ministries."

The Legacy Society has future initiatives planned, including Information nights where parishioners will be educated on estate planning, funeral planning, and other ministries at Resurrection. While the Legacy Society starts these important conversations, The Catholic Foundation is a great partner that can step in and answer any questions parishioners might have regarding charitable giving. Jim said, "We have been really well received by many of the people. One person came up to me at the last gathering and told me how surprised they were at the many options available to them for planned giving – something they automatically assumed they couldn't do before. And it's getting better. People are slowly becoming more informed on the resources available to them and realizing what their own capacity is for giving."

The mission of the Kyrie Bequest Society (KBS) is to recognize those individuals who have notified The Catholic Foundation of their plan to leave a future gift through a bequest, trust, life insurance policy, retirement plan, or charitable gift annuity through the Foundation. Specific parishes, schools, or organizations may be designated as beneficiaries.

Rachelle Martin is a new member to KBS but has been a friend to The Catholic Foundation for over ten years. When Rachelle served as Executive Director of Catholic Ministries, she worked closely with former Foundation President and CEO, Jennifer Damiano. Their friendship grew over the years and Rachelle helped Jennifer recruit Andrew Walker and Charles Rowan to the Foundation's Board of Trustees. It was Andrew Walker that first planted the seed of Rachelle opening an endowment fund at the Foundation and it has stuck with her ever since. To get an idea as to why Rachelle wanted to open an endowment fund, however, we will have to learn a little more about her journey.

Rachelle and her family converted to Catholicism when she was in the 4th grade. They became parishioners of St. Dominic parish in Columbus, Ohio and her mother was in the choir for over 25 years. Rachelle said that St. Dominic was one of the most welcoming and evangelistic churches she had ever experienced. Rachelle attributes much of her giving to her mother and how she was raised. Her mother instilled in her, and her sister, the path of love and charity, which helps her see the value of giving both her time and resources to her parish, St. Dominic. Rachelle has taken this to heart by establishing an endowment fund, which will be funded by her with a \$125,000 life insurance policy benefit.

In addition to St. Dominic, Rachelle named three other organizations that are very near and dear to her as annual



beneficiaries of the fund: Mother Angeline McCrory Manor, National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), and the Dominican Sisters of Peace.

- Mother Angeline McCrory Manor is a not-for-profit facility that provides skilled nursing services and spiritual care in a safe and home-like environment. The focus is on each resident's medical needs and the enhancement of their quality of life. Rachelle's mother has Alzheimer's and is currently a Manor resident. "They are truly amazing and wonderful with my mother. They take excellent care of her and they love her like I love her," said Rachelle.
- NAMI is an advocacy group originally founded as
 a grassroots group by family members of people
 diagnosed with mental illness. NAMI identifies its
 mission as being "dedicated to building better lives for
 the millions of Americans affected by mental illness".
 Rachelle has been the Executive Director at NAMI for
 over ten years. She said, "It is an amazing organization.
 We help people who are living with a mental illness and
 their families. There are 13 staff members that work with
 me at NAMI and they are some of the most amazing
 and inspiring individuals. There isn't a day that goes by
 where we don't touch other people's lives...their souls."
- Dominican Sisters of Peace is a congregation of Catholic Dominicans with about 600 Sisters and 500 Associates living and serving in 37 states and in eight additional countries. Rachelle says she accidentally came upon them when a friend recommended her as a volunteer to lector for the nuns at Mohun health care, which she has done on a monthly basis for the past five years.

Rachelle worked with Scott Hartman, VP of Development, to create a plan that fit this stage of her journey and encompassed all of the causes she cared most about.

Rachelle said, "I think one of the most important things for me during this process was the trust I had in The Catholic Foundation. I trust that the money I have to give will be invested and handled with respect and is in alignment with the faith that has guided me my whole life."



FINANCIAL DISCLOSURES

The Foundation of the Catholic Diocese of Columbus (the Foundation) was incorporated in 1984 and organized as an Ohio non-profit corporation. The Foundation's purpose is to receive gifts and bequests and to dedicate their use primarily for religious, educational and charitable activities in connection with and for the benefit of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Columbus. All authority of the Foundation is vested in and exercised by its Board of Trustees.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements of the Foundation are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and, accordingly, reflect all significant revenues, expenses, assets, liabilities and net assets of the Foundation. The Foundation is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets. Temporarily restricted net assets consist of funds restricted by time or purpose by the donors to support program activities. Permanently restricted net assets consist of restricted funds that are to be held in perpetuity with income available to support donor advised and general operating purposes.

AGENCY FUNDS

The Foundation is required to record contributions from donors for the benefit of a specified beneficiary as agency funds. The Foundation is the recipient organization that acts as an agent for a beneficiary if it agrees to solicit assets from potential donors specifically for the beneficiary's use and to distribute those assets or the return from investing those assets to the beneficiary

INVESTMENT POOLS

The Foundation utilizes common investment pools to manage most of its investments. The earnings from investments (interest and dividends) as well as investment gains and losses of the pools are allocated to the individual fund according to its percentage of ownership of the investment pool.

DISTRIBUTION POLICY

The Foundation's distribution policy is to distribute an amount up to 5% of the average market value over 12 rolling quarters.

ANNUITIES AND CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUSTS

The Foundation administers various charitable annuity and remainder trust agreements with donors. The arrangements provide for agreed upon distributions over a designated period of time (usually the designated beneficiary's lifetime or a term of years). A liability has been recorded equal to the present value of the estimated future obligation. This obligation amount includes the present value of all anticipated payments to the donors based on their life expectancy or a term of years. The Foundation revalues this liability annually.

TAX STATUS

The Foundation is a publicly supported charitable organization that is exempt from federal and state taxes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
