# Message from Loren Brown, CEO & President

Not long ago, I met with Susan Lewis Kaylor, President & CEO of St. Vincent Family Services, to brainstorm ways her team could continue to support families who struggle with the challenges of finding behavioral health care for their children. After some dialogue, we agreed it would be beneficial for St. Vincent to renovate their current residential treatment facility which hadn't been updated since the 1990s. A facility update would enable them to improve services across multiple disciplines while giving their clinical and administrative staff a safer, more efficient space to serve children and caretakers.

In June 2023, Susan's vision became a reality when St. Vincent Family Services started construction to update their residential treatment facility. Through the generosity of our donors, The Catholic Foundation made a multi-year commitment to help with funding through our responsive grants program. This is one of many stories of real-world impact that I'm blessed to witness daily.

Helping our donors create real-world impact is something my team and I take to heart. It's not about The Catholic Foundation! It is the impact on souls the Foundation has in the 23-county diocese of Columbus. Our impact is an investment in the future of the Catholic faith. As you read the 2023 Annual Report of The Foundation of the Catholic Diocese of Columbus, allow me to express my heartfelt gratitude for your generosity and support of the Foundation and those charitable causes that help us build up the Church and increase the Kingdom of God in the world. As those who have been called by Christ, we are also sent on a mission to bring the Good News into the whole world.

When I was installed as Bishop of Columbus, grateful for the heritage of faith left by my predecessors, I was already looking forward to the good things to come in the diocese and beyond. Our region is poised to grow, and, if we are to provide for the spiritual and material needs of future generations, then we need to have a solid foundation.

To that end, I prioritized vocations and evangelization. Each one of us is called first in baptism. We are blessed with lay missionaries, and we are seeing success at the Newman Center at The Ohio State University and campus ministries throughout the diocese, with increased participation in Mass, ministries, Bible studies, and the like, through the continued efforts of these dedicated young people.

Our diocese continues to grow, especially in its ethnic diversity. The Catholic Foundation was able to fund critical outreach to our Hispanic community and also sponsored African immigrants to attend the African Eucharistic Congress in Washington, DC. These new groups remind us of the universality of the Church, whose diverse gifts are harmonized by the Spirit.

The Foundation's consistent support of all twenty-three counties in the diocese of Columbus, including many of our rural counties, as well as its ongoing funding of social outreach, Catholic education, youth ministry, and evangelization efforts in our parishes, is vital for future generations – your children and grandchildren – to have faith.

#### FINANCIAL DISCLOSURES

The Foundation of the Catholic Diocese of Columbus (the Foundation) was incorporated in 1984 and organized as an Ohio non-profit corporation. The Foundation's purpose is to receive gifts and bequests and to dedicate their use primarily to religious, educational, and charitable activities in connection with and for the benefit of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Columbus. All authority of the Foundation is vested in and exercised by its Board of Trustees.

#### **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

The Foundation's financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and, accordingly, reflect all significant revenues, expenses, assets, liabilities, and net assets of the Foundation. The Foundation is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to two classes of net assets: net assets without donor restrictions and net assets with donor restrictions.

#### **AGENCY FUNDS**

The Foundation is required to record contributions from donors for the benefit of a specified beneficiary as agency funds. The Foundation is the recipient organization that acts as an agent for a beneficiary if it agrees to solicit assets from potential donors specifically for the beneficiary's use and to distribute those assets or the return from investing those assets to the beneficiary.

#### **INVESTMENT POOLS**

The Foundation utilizes common investment pools to manage most of its investments. The earnings from investments (interest and dividends) as well as investment gains and losses of the pools are allocated to the individual fund according to its percentage of ownership of the investment pool.

#### **DISTRIBUTION POLICY**

The Foundation's distribution policy is to distribute an amount up to 5% of the average market value over twelve rolling quarters.

#### **ANNUITIES AND CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUSTS**

The Foundation administers various charitable annuities and remainder trust agreements with donors. The arrangements provide for agreed-upon distributions over a designated time (usually the designated beneficiary's lifetime or a term of years). A liability has been recorded equal to the present value of the estimated future obligation. This obligation amount includes the present value of all anticipated payments to the donors based on their life expectancy or a term of years. The Foundation revalues this liability annually.

#### **TAX STATUS**

The Foundation is a publicly supported charitable organization that is exempt from federal and state taxes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### **AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**
